## **Knarston Creek Construction Update**

Construction of the Knarston Creek Overflow project is well underway and construction is presently on schedule. We would like to take this opportunity to notify the community that **significant traffic pattern changes** are anticipated during this time of construction, specifically that portion of Lantzville Road between Benwaldun and Shangri-la Roads. Individuals who find they travel this portion of the roadway are encouraged to proceed slowly and with caution, respecting both the traffic control signage and personnel on-site. Further, we would also like to advise the community that construction will see that portion of Lantzville Road, again, between Benwaldun and Shangri-la Roads closed to all traffic, albeit temporarily, towards the end of September. Staff of the District, the District's engineers and the contractor will define an alternate route and will make every effort to minimize this closure and the impact it may have on the residents in the area. ## **Minetown Day Parade – Road Closure**

Council of the District of Lantzville has approved the closure of that portion of Lantzville Road between Ware Road and Lantzville School Road from 9:45 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. (1.25 hours) on Saturday, September 11<sup>th</sup>, 2010, to facilitate the Minetown Day Parade. Traffic control individuals will be present to redirect traffic through Lantzville via alternate routes. The District of Lantzville thanks you for your cooperation during this yearly community celebration.

## **Phase 2 Sewer Rebate - Reminder**

Property owners who complete their individual property connection to the system by September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2010, will be entitled to a \$1,000 refund. Property owners subject to a pump purchase have until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011, to facilitate their connection and be entitled to a \$1,000 refund.

## **Garbage, Recycling & Organic Food Waste**

We have been communicating that the District will be moving forward with a change in both service provider and collection methods as it relates to the collection of garbage, recycling and food waste effective October 2010. In anticipation of these changes there are 2 information sessions scheduled for residents of the District of Lantzville, as follows:

- **Drop-In - Wednesday, September 15**, between the hours of **2:00 p.m. – 5:00 p.m.** at the District Office (2<sup>nd</sup> Floor); and/or
- **Open House - Wednesday, September 22**; **2:00 – 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 – 9:00 p.m.** at Costin Hall, 7232 Lantzville Road.
