Council Update - In November, Council:

- authorized carrying forward 2016 Parks and Recreation projects to the 2017 budget
- declined KPMG's October 31, 2016 proposal to increase audit fees for the 2016 audit
- authorized a temporary full-time Deputy Director of Financial Services position for a term ending December 31, 2017
- adopted 2016-2020 Financial Plan Bylaw No. 120, 2016, Amendment Bylaw No. 134, 2016
- adopted Council Procedure Bylaw No. 118, 2016
- directed staff to prepare reports on a Council Code of Conduct and on managing information associated with planning applications received by the District
- provided \$1,000 to the Lantzville Volunteer Firefighter Association in support of their 2016 Volunteer Firefighter (VF) Christmas Party and will consider during the 2017 budget deliberations, providing the same amount for the 2017 VF Christmas Party and provisions for a Council-hosted VF appreciation dinner
- adopted Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 50, 2005, Amendment Bylaw No. 50.7, 2016
- adopted Zoning Bylaw No. 60, 2005, Amendment (7491 Lantzville Rd) Bylaw No. 60.33, 2016
- appointed Councillor Geselbracht as representative and Councillor Neary as alternate, to the Vancouver Island Regional Library Board of Trustees serving until December 31, 2017
- appointed Councillor Swain as member and Councillor Geselbracht as alternate, on the City of Nanaimo Parks, Recreation & Wellness Select Committee
- appointed Councillor Colclough as municipal director and Councillor Neary as alternate, on the Regional District of Nanaimo Board.
