

**DISTRICT OF LANTZVILLE**

**BYLAW NO. 2003 - 9**

**A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH A PARKS RESERVE FUND**

**WHEREAS:**

- A.** The Letters Patent Order-in-Council 0369 dated April 3, 2003 incorporating the District of Lantzville require Council by bylaw to establish certain Reserve Funds into which reserve funds of the Lantzville Improvement District can be transferred;
- B.** Section 496 of the *Local Government Act* empowers Council by bylaw to establish Capital Works Reserve Funds;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the District of Lantzville in open meeting assembled hereby enacts as follows:

Citation

- 1. This by-law may be cited for all purposes as "Parks Reserve Fund Bylaw No. 2003 -9".

Reserve Fund

- 2. There shall be and is hereby established a renewal reserve fund pursuant to Section 496 of the *Local Government Act* to be known as the "Parks Reserve Fund".
- 3. The Lantzville Improvement District will pay over, at June 25, 2003, any money held in their Reserve Fund established under Bylaw 308 and this will be the initial deposit of monies to this newly created "Parks Reserve Fund".
- 4. Money from current revenue or, as available, from general revenue surplus, or as otherwise provided in the *Local Government Act*, may be paid into this reserve fund.
- 5. Money set aside, and interest earned on it, may only be used for capital works including land acquisition, land development, equipment acquisition and upgrading, replacement or renewal of existing assets.

**READ A FIRST TIME** this 25th day of June 2003.

**READ A SECOND TIME** this 25th day of June 2003.

**READ A THIRD TIME** this 25th day of June 2003.

**FINALLY ADOPTED** this 14<sup>th</sup> day of July 2003.
